<u>With regard to the payment s</u> <u>related to the in -service issues of the Trent 1000 engine</u>

1. Outline

We participate as a risk and revenue sharing partner on the Rolls -Royce Trent 1000 engine program, which has been impacted by the challenge of managing significant in -service issues. Rolls-Royce continues to work hard to remedy this situation and has made further substantial progress on the implementation of long-term solutions and mitigation of the near -term impa ct on customers. As member of this program, we would cover our portion of the cash costs associated with in -service issues. In the financial results for second quarter FY2018, we will make a provision of approximately ¥ 10bn representing the allowance for the abnormal cost related to Airworthiness Directives which mandated additional inspections .

The amount of the financial impact due to the issue stated above is included in "Revision of the O utlook for performance for the F iscal Year Ending March 3 1, 2019" announced today .

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
