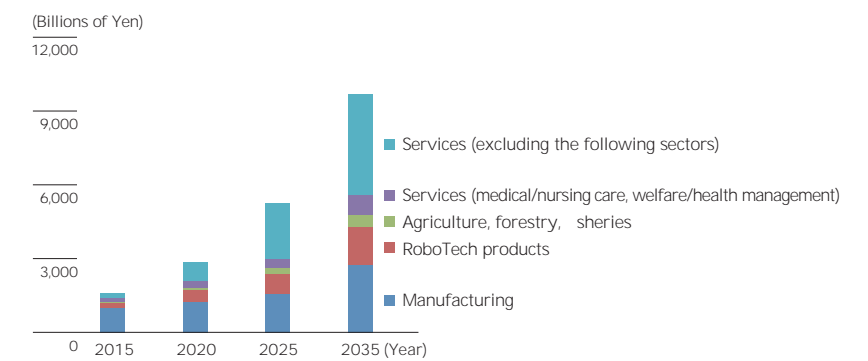
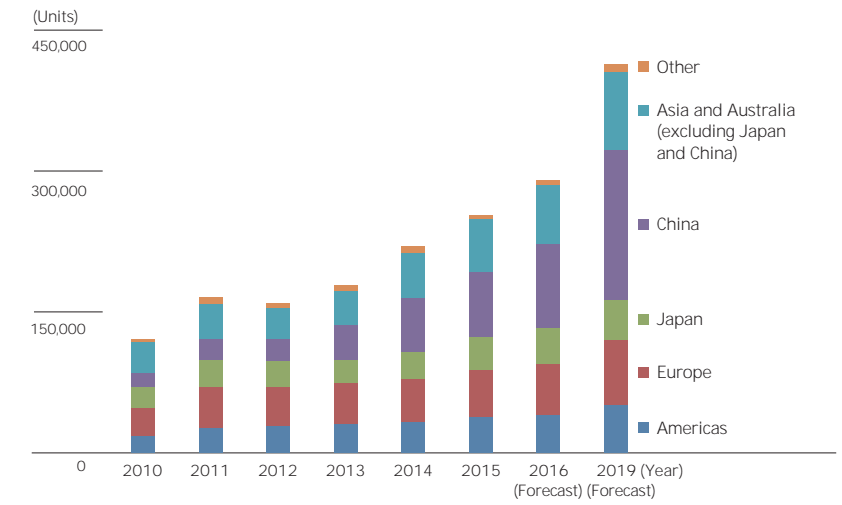


Discovering
